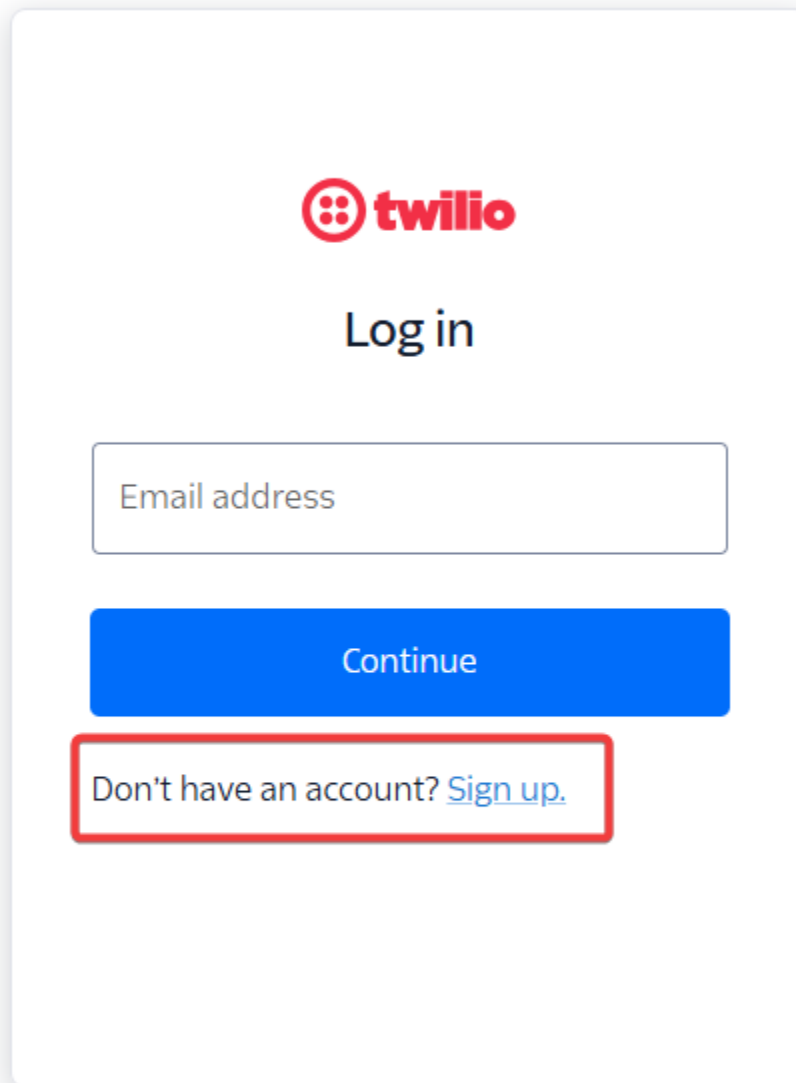


Creating a Twilio Trial Account for 2FA SMS Authentication

This document outlines the steps to set up a free Twilio trial account for implementing two-factor authentication (2FA) via SMS, as of October 2025.

1. Navigate to <https://www.twilio.com/login> and click on Sign Up.
