
Creating a Twilio Trial Account for 2FA SMS Authentication


This document outlines the steps to set up a free Twilio trial account for implementing two-factor authentication (2FA) via SMS, as of October 2025.

1. Navigate to https://www.twilio.com/login and click on Sign Up.





1. Sign up for a trial account






- 2. Verify the passcode sent to your email
- 3. Add a phone number for verification




Note: Same phone number can be used on multiple accounts

Note: Phone numbers are mandatory for SMS services



- 4. Once you are in the Account Dashboard / landing page, note down the Account SID and the Auth Token and save them for later use in the authentication workflow
- 5. Also click on "Get A Trial phone number" to get a source phone number that will be used to sent SMS codes



6. Copy and note down the My Twilio phone number for Smart Zone / RUCKUSOne integration
